Your vestry is delighted to join the School community in welcoming a new Head—Mr. Peter Reinke, who succeeds Debbi David. Selected with enthusiasm by the School Board after a national search, Mr. Reinke comes to St. James' with two kinds of credentials—as an educator and as a devoted Episcopalian.

He is an experienced teacher and administrator, having most recently served as Assistant Head of School at the Buckley School in Los Angeles, where he helped lead a project to revise their curriculum to incorporate 21st century theories of teaching and learning. Before coming to Buckley Mr. Reinke taught at the Head-Royce School in Oakland, CA. He holds an undergraduate degree from Brown University and a graduate degree from Teachers' College of Columbia University.

Mr. Reinke is also a life-long Episcopalian, currently serving as Senior Warden and Lay Eucharistic Minister at the Church of the Advent in Los Angeles.
