Today we welcome Paul Yeager, violinist. Paul sent us his bio, to give us a bit of background about himself:

"Paul Yeager has studied violin under many teachers, beginning with his mother Jane Yeager, and later including Mimi Zweig, Kurt Sassmannshaus, Charles Castleman, and Bettina Mussumeli. As a prodigy, Paul toured Europe where he played in halls in Germany, Switzerland, Austria, and Turkey. He premiered a modern work by then-CCM composer-in-residence Gerhart Samuel, "Transformations," in Alice Tully Hall, Lincoln Center, at the age of 12. He appears on three compact discs. He finally graduated with a Bachelor of Music degree from SF Conservatory of Music in 2009, although these days he's largely pursuing his career as a work-from-home computer programmer.

Paul found salvation in Jesus Christ in a Christian hospital in February, 2017, while having lived in Bangkok, Thailand for three years, and soon after decided to return home to the US to be nearer to his family. He was inspired to live in Koreatown in large part by the diverse food options, however more likely: by historical-spiritual proximity to the Azusa Street Revivals and the saving grace of the Lord as so gloriously-manifest in St. James, which he was so blessed to have first arrived in for Christmas Eve 2017!"
