Greetings! We invite you to join the book group after the 10:30am service in the conference room of the parish offices (2<sup>nd</sup> floor) as we discuss 'Gasil', written by Yi Kwang-su, who is regarded as a pioneer of modern fiction and a leading voice in modern Korean literature. 'Gasil' is a story based on the tale of *Seol's Daughter and Gasil* appearing in *The History of the Three Kingdoms*, which deals with the moral and heroic acts of a young farmer. To keep his promise to Seol's daughter, Gasil faces danger in ferocious battles and overcomes the temptation from his master's daughter. The story, which touches on faithfulness, spirituality, loyalty, respect, and inner conflict, serve to highlight Gasil's upright character and becomes a means of expressing the author's views on morality while inflecting Korean history, tradition, culture, respect, and loyalty throughout. ### Social Media Sunday, September 30<sup>th</sup>

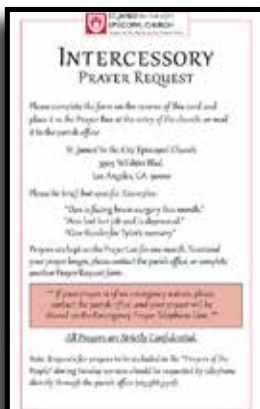
