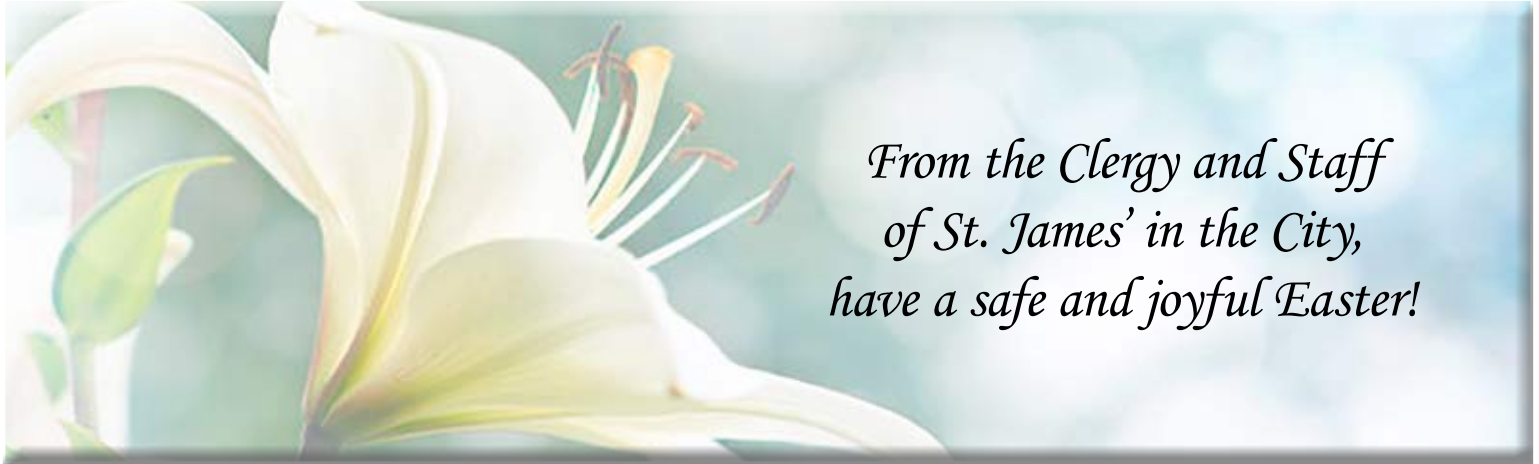




Welcome to St. James' in the City!
