Today we welcome the Applied Music Choir, led by Eunsook Zeifelder, Professor, Director Jiwoo Jung, and sixteen singers who are touring in the United States. We are blessed to have this talented group sing anthems for the Offertory and for Communion.

Created in 2006, the Department of Applied Music endeavors to cultivate innovative and intellectual musicians. They are dedicated to supporting students in this age of new media. The University offers individual practice rooms and ensemble rooms for each major. In addition, it has outdoor and indoor concert halls with high sound quality and recording studios that are on par with A-class studios.



Students may choose from several sub-majors: Vocals; Guitar; Keyboard; Bass Guitar; Drum and Music Production (computer music and applied music composition). The

Department of Applied Music has a specialized curriculum where theoretical and practical programs are combined with field classes utilizing our industrial-academic cooperative alliances. There is also a permanent Career System Course to develop artists who exemplify various musical capabilities and a desire to enter the public arena as professional players, music trainers, broadcast musicians, performance organizers, music directors and individual creators.
