About the artists. . .

For more than four decades, the Pacific Trio has been dazzling concert audiences throughout North America and Europe. The ensemble, founded in 1979 by pianist Edith Orloff and cellist John Walz, was joined in 2000 by violinist Roger Wilkie. The trio toured the United States and Canada for many years under the auspices of Columbia Artists Management; in 1986, they made their New York debut at Lincoln Center's Alice Tully Hall. On that occasion The New York Times wrote, "The members of the trio played with warmth, expertise, and unanimity..... elegantly tapered, yet directly emotive playing." In 1995, they made their European debut with concerts in Germany, France, and the Czech Republic.

Since then, they have re-visited the major music centers of Paris, Munich, Hamburg, Prague, Krakow, Alsace, and St. Petersburg, among others. The trio has become a favorite of the Bagno Konzertgalerie in Steinfurt, Germany, one of the oldest and most revered recital halls in Europe. Along with the standard trio fare, the ensemble's extensive repertoire includes works by American composers as well as by those whose lives were impacted during the Third Reich. The trio has also performed Beethoven's Triple Concerto with many orchestras, ultimately recording it with the Czech National Symphony following a celebrated performance at Prague's legendary Rudolfinum. The Pacific Trio is also well-represented on CD with recordings of trios by Brahms and Shostakovich; American composers (Gershwin, Copland, Bernstein, Muczynski); trios of Korngold and Zemlinsky; and Beethoven's "Archduke" Trio. The three colleagues enjoy sharing their artistry with young people, serving as Trio-in-Residence and founders of the summer chamber music workshop at Idyllwild Arts Academy.

Please join us next week, May 26 at 6 PM, for our final concert this season. The International Laureates Organ Series in cooperation with the American Guild of Organists will present Bruce Neswick in a program to include the world premiere of a work by the award-winning Korean-American composer Texu Kim. In addition Dr. Neswick will perform the Prelude and Fugue in Eb Major (St. Anne) by Bach, "Te Deum Laudamus" by David Hurd, the Prelude and Fugue in Ab Major by Marcel Dupré, and will conclude with an Improvisation on a submitted theme.
