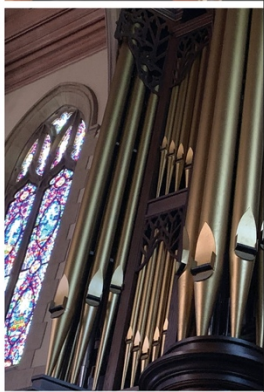

### *About the artists. . .*

Formed in 2013 by award-winning international concert pianists Giorgi Latso and his wife Anna Fedorova-Latso, the **Latsos Duo** has been praised for its “brilliance and stylistic insight” by *Los Angeles Weekly*, while *International Piano Magazine* calls the duo “alluring, thrilling, and inspirational.” They perform at renowned concert halls across Europe, America, Western Asia, and the Middle East, and have recorded a number of unusual and largely unknown treasures from the duo-piano repertoire, including all the Schubert duets and duos. They have also arranged and performed two-piano and piano-four-hands transcriptions from American movie scores by composers such as John Williams, Erich Wolfgang Korngold, and John Philip Sousa. The Latsos are often guests on radio such as KUSC, Classic FM, *Sundays Live*, NDR Kultur, and WAMU, Washington’s NPR station, among others. As music educators, they are regularly invited to present collegiate masterclasses and lectures at a number of universities in Europe, Russia, and Asia, as well as across the United States, and often serve as judges at international, national, and regional piano competitions. They offer concert performances for non-profit organizations and institutions that serve underprivileged communities, children with special needs, hospital patients, and the elderly. In 2024 they created the Amadeus International Foundation with the mission to recognize and nurture young and talented pianists.
