The Ed and Mari Edelman Chamber Music Institute offers one of the most comprehensive and intense precollege level chamber music learning experiences of any music school in North America. Students are coached weekly by members of the nationally acclaimed faculty of the Colburn Community School of Performing Arts. Ensembles from the Institute have been prizewinners in numerous competitions, including the Fischoff Competition, the Coleman Chamber Music Competition and the Young Artists Peninsula Music Festival, and have received engagements to perform on the nationally syndicated Public Radio International Series *From the Top* as well as with the Chamber Music Society at Lincoln Center.

#### Upcoming...

We invite you to join us on Sunday, May 11, when the Choir of Saint James will sing its final Choral Evensong of the season at 4:15 PM. Music to be performed includes the Canticles in G Major by Herbert Sumsion, *Trahe me post te* by Francisco Guerrero, the Responses by James Buonemani, and *Lux Aeterna* - a choral setting by John Cameron of Elgar's *Nimrod* from his *Enigma Variations*.

One week later, May 18 at 6 PM, we mark the end of an era – the last episode of *Classical Sundays at Six/Sundays Live* featuring series stalwarts and longtime colleagues, the "Magnificent Seven" ensemble: Michele Zukovsky, clarinet; Judith Farmer, bassoon; Amy Jo Rhine, horn; Phillip Levy, violin; Erik Reynearson, viola; John Walz, cello; and Edward Meares, bass. They will perform Beethoven's Septet in Eflat Major, Opus 20.

*Great Music at Saint James* will begin its thirtieth season with a Choral Evensong on October 12, 2025. The International Laureates Organ Series will begin inside our renovated church building on February 8, 2026, featuring acclaimed artist Nathaniel Gumbs.
